What you will need

- Mac OS X
- Safari Browser
- Dashboard
- Scissors
- Glue
- Mixing Bowl



Widget-Making Recipe

- Open Safari Browser to your favorite URL:
 - Washington Apple Pi
- Go to Safari's File Menu and click on:
 - Open in Dashboard ...
- Safari will ask you to move the white box to select the part of web page to use in creating the widget.
 - In our case we will select this part of the Wap.org page including the Home, Calendar and other hyperlinked buttons.
 - Click the Add Button on the right in the browser window.
- Once you click Add, the dashboard widget is created; you can click on the Home, Calendar and other links and Safari will take you the corresponding page at Wap.org.

- You can use the widget to keep in touch with Pi activities, events and news.
- On your iPhone, create a widget of Wap.org by using Safari's "+" button and choosing "Add to Home Screen"
